

Year 2 Autumn 2 – Maybe it's because I'm a Londoner

Topic Overview

In Autumn 2, children will be exploring where Abbey Wood is in relation to London. The children will learn about the human and physical features of London including the River Thames and different landmarks e.g., Big Ben, The London Eye etc.

<u>Educational visit:</u> As part of our science topic – everyday materials, we will be visiting the local area and completing a material hunt, looking for different materials in the environment.

Our Learning Overview Key Texts In writing, we will be composing a setting description based on one of the London **English** landmarks. We will also be researching famous places in London and creating factfiles. In maths, we will be looking at numbers within 100, adding and subtracting these Maths numbers and putting them into word problems. Maybe it's because I'm a Londoner In science, we will be learning about everyday materials. We will indentify, classify and Science describe them while performing investigations to test material suitability. In geography, we will be identifying where Abbey Wood is in relation to London. We will also be exploring the different human and physical features including the River Thames Geography and different London landmarks. In art, children will develop their understanding of printing. We will be using pencil to create a London scene then covering with paint to press onto material to make an Art impression. In RE, our focus question is - How should we care for others and why does it matter? We RE are going to learn about Christianity and how this question links to this religion. In music, we will continue to learn how to play the recorder. We will be learning to follow Music a simple rhythm and also how to read musical notes.
