



Year 3 Spring 1 - Failed Caesar!

Topic Overview

In Spring 1, the children will learn all about the Romans - this will be across their Reading, Writing and History lessons. In writing they will be reading the 'Roman Diary: The Journal of Iliona'. The children will be revisiting topics learnt in Year 3 to consolidate and deepen their learning. The children will be taking part in a debate as to what they think the Romans brought to Britain and what we use today.

Hook: Thursday 4th January. Children to discover Roman artefacts and try to work out what each artefact was used for.

Our Learning Overview

Failed Caesar

English

In Writing we will be writing our own flashback narrative based on a day in life of a Roman. We will be learning about Iliona's life as a young Roman child.

Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing our learning of multiplication and division before moving on to length and perimeter.

Science

In Science, we will be reflecting on what we have learnt so far this year; Animals including humans, Plants and Rocks, Lights and Magnets.

History

In History, we are going to be looking at *Did everyone like the Romans?* We will explore who the Romans are, what they brought to Britain and what happened when they invaded Britain.

Art

In Art children are going to be looking at collages. We will then create our own mosaic.

PD/RE

In Personal Development the children will be learning about health and relationships. We will look at money and work. In RE, children will be looking at what different people believe in God.

Music

In Music, children will be exploring how music shapes our way of life, as they look at a range of different musical styles.
