



Year 3 Spring 2 Which Way Now?

Topic Overview

In Spring 2 the children will be learning about reading Ordnance Survey maps and their different symbols. They will be using Digi Maps to identify different features of their local area and learn how to read 4 and 6 grid references. They will conduct a fieldwork investigation to see how their local area has changed over time.

Our Learning Overview

Which Way Now?

English

In English the children will be writing their own journey tale based around our core text, Journey. They will also write a character and setting description.

Maths

In Maths the children will be exploring fractions. They will learn how to count fractions on a number line and compare non-unit fractions.

Science

In Science, the children will be learning all about plants. They will revisit what makes a living thing, the features of a plant and conduct an investigation about what is the ideal space for a plant to grow in.

Geography

In Geography the children will be exploring different types of maps, focusing on reading and interpreting OS Maps using the online resource Digi Maps. They will also learn how to read 4 and 6 grid references.

Art

In Art this term they will be focusing on drawing portraits.

PHSE/RE

In RE the children will be exploring the question 'what do different people believe about God?'. They will learn about different religious beliefs surrounding God.

Music

In Music, we will continue to learn the ukelele with our specialist music teacher.
