Topic Overview


In Autumn 2, we will be looking at the features of a river. We will understand the role of the water cycle and how it works. We will learn why rivers are so important as both a natural resource and a source of economy. We will look at key rivers around the world (including, Thames, Danube and Colorado) and compare and contrast them.

Hook: The children will become Marine Biologists. Using facts, research and maps, the children will investigate how a whale ended up in the river Thames. Can they come up with any theories?
